Ancestors of Mary Rose Garlick

First Generation

1. Mary Rose Garlick, daughter of **Joseph Francis Garlick** and **Hezibah Belcher**, was born on 5 Aug 1862 in Wahgunyah, VIC, died on 17 Dec 1929 in Wodonga West, VIC at age 67, and was buried on 18 Dec 1929 in Old Albury Cemetary (RC section, sect. E, row A, plot 4), NSW. The cause of her death was Heart failure.

General Notes: On her marriage certificate, Mary's occupation at the age of 20 is given as "domestic servant".

Medical Notes: An inquest into Mary's death was held on the day of her death to formally determine the cause.

Mary married **Hugh Richard Cochrane**, son of **John Evan Cochrane** and **Margaret Ann Looney**, on 10 Apr 1883 in Chiltern at bride's residence.

Marriage Notes: The marriage ceremony was conducted at the bride's residence in Chiltern by the local Church of England minister.

General Notes: As a young man Hugh was a dancer at night in Sydney and a bricklayer during the day. At the age of 26 when Hugh married Mary Rose Garlick, his trade was listed as "bricklayer".

Hugh was lucky enough to win 10,000 pounds in Tatts. He bought a farming property with it at Wodonga West and built a house they called "Temple Court".

Hugh and his family were renowned as builders at the time and they constructed or helped in the construction of many noteworthy buildings in the Albury-Wodonga district, amongst them being the old Wodonga Post Office, the Presbytery at St Augustine's Church and the old Albury Base Hospital.

Children from this marriage were:

- i. **John (Jack) Evan Cochrane** was born in 1883 in Albury, NSW, died on 14 Apr 1902 in Albury Base Hospital, NSW at age 19, and was buried on 15 Apr 1902 in Albury Pioneer Cemetery, NSW (RC sect. E, row A, plot 6).
- ii. **Edward Cochrane** was born on 24 Jan 1885 in Albury, NSW and died on 5 May 1976 in Sydney, NSW at age 91. Edward married **Alice M Fulford** in 1911 in Albury, NSW.
- iii. **Hugh Richard Cochrane** was born in 1887 in Albury, NSW, died on 24 Feb 1904 in Albury, NSW at age 17, and was buried on 26 Feb 1904 in Albury Pioneer Cemetery, NSW (RC sect. E, row A, plot 5). The cause of his death was (1) Accidental death - thrown off horse while riding.
- iv. **Clarence Charles Cochrane** was born on 31 Oct 1890 in Wodonga, VIC, died on 23 Apr 1959 in Wodonga, VIC at age 68, and was buried on 24 Apr 1959 in Wodonga Cemetery, VIC (C of E, row F plot 69). Clarence married **Lily Ada Weeks** on 17 May 1910 in Albury, NSW.
- v. **Sidney William Cochrane** was born on 17 Jun 1891 in Albury, NSW and died in Oct 1975 in Murrumbidgee, VIC at age 84. The cause of his death was Heart Attack, died instantly while mowing the lawn. Sidney married **Greta Albrighton** in 1919 in Victoria, Australia.
- vi. **Alfred Beaumont Cochrane** was born on 17 May 1893 in "Temple Court", Wodonga West, VIC, died on 16 May 1984 at age 90, and was buried on 18 May 1984. Alfred married **Ivy M Burrows** in 1920 in Albury, NSW.
- vii. **Maurice Cochrane** was born on 24 Nov 1895 in "Temple Court", Wodonga, VIC and died on 17 Apr 1973 in Melbourne, VIC at age 77. Maurice married **May E. H. Kierath** in 1917 in Albury, NSW.
- viii. **Leo Royal Cochrane** was born on 18 Aug 1897 in "Temple Court", Wodonga West, VIC, died on 25 Jul 1980 in Osborne Lodge, Wodonga, VIC at age 82, and was buried on 28 Jul 1980 in Wodonga Cemetery, VIC (R/C Row H, plot 23). The cause of his death was (1) Cerebrovascular accident - minutes (2) Atherosclerosis - years (3) Diabetes - months. Leo married **Lillian May Dalglish**, daughter of

- Thomas Dalgliesh** and **Gustava Teresa Ostrom**, on 7 Apr 1920 in St Augustine's Catholic Church, Wodonga, VIC.
- ix. **Reginald Cochrane** was born on 3 Sep 1900 in "Temple Court", Wodonga West, VIC and died on 19 May 1970 in Sydney, NSW at age 69. Reginald married **Caroline I Organ** in 1924 in Sydney, NSW. Reginald next married **Gladys Harriet Needle** in 1942 in Drummoyne, NSW.
- x. **Margaret Elizabeth Cochrane** was born in 1902 in "Temple Court", Wodonga West, VIC and was buried on 29 Jul 1902 in Albury Pioneer Cemetery, NSW (RC sect. E, row A, plot 6). The cause of her death was Unknown.
- xi. **Isabelle Mary Cochrane** was born on 23 Jul 1905 in "Temple Court", Wodonga West, VIC, died on 28 Feb 1985 in Osborne Lodge, Wodonga, VIC at age 79, and was buried in 1985 in Wodonga Cemetery, VIC. Isabelle married **Edward William Frederick (Fred) Bartel**.

Second Generation (Parents)

2. Joseph Francis Garlick, son of **James Garlick** and **Elizabeth Ann Allnutt**, was born in 1829 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England., was christened on 15 Jul 1829 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England., died on 14 Aug 1871 in "Lapthorne Farm", near Chiltern, Vic. at age 42, and was buried on 17 Aug 1871 in "Lapthorne Farm", near Chiltern, Vic.. The cause of his death was (1) Phthisis (tuberculosis) - unknown duration.

General Notes: **Joseph Francis Garlick** grew up at Garlick's Farm in Ewelme Village. In the 1841 Oxfordshire Census, **Joseph** (aged 12) is recorded living at the Ewelme School with his father James (schoolmaster - aged 50), mother Elizabeth (aged 40), brother William Allnutt (aged 19), brother Septimus (aged 15), sister Rose (aged 10), brother John (aged 9), sister Ann (aged 7) and sister Alicia Jane (aged 3).

Joseph emigrated to Australia in about 1849 at the age of 20. His bride-to-be Hepzibah Belcher emigrated to Australia in about 1851. They were married in Melbourne in 1853. His occupation at the time of his marriage to Hepzibah Belcher was "Carrier", his actual place of residence at the time of the marriage was given as "Collingwood" (presumably where he was boarding) and his usual (or home) residence given as "Murray River".

After they were married in Melbourne, they moved north, presumably to the Chiltern district. Official records indicate that a few years later in 1856, **Joseph** purchased '*Eldorado Station*' (the western part of the Barambogie Run near Beechworth Rd) from a Mr Jason Withers and then held it for 4-5 years (up to about 1861). Shortly after this purchase was made, strong rumours began regarding the likelihood of finding massive deposits of alluvial gold in the area of Black Dog Creek. Another property then called "*Hillgreen*" is situated on the left hand side along the Black Dog road, just before the right-hand turn off to Deep Creek road and belonged to the family of William and Annie Ashley (nee Withers). Alfred Eustace and members of the Withers families had grown up in Berkshire, England, prior to coming to Australia, so Annie named "*Hillgreen*" after the fond memories that she had of her grandfather's home in Berkshire. From '*Hillgreen*', the view of Mt. Pilot stretches across the the "**Eldorado Park Station**", where a brick home was built in 1844 by Captain W. F. Baker RN, with iron lace windows for security. This property of 320 acres was bought from the Captain by Jason Withers in 1851 and was freeholded in 1855 after which Jason on-sold the Eldorado Station 320 acres in 1856 to **Joseph Garlick**. On 30 January 1860, Jason sold 10 acres of his Ullina run to his brother William by pre-emptive right, a condition where squatters held the right to buy land at 1 pound per acre from the Crown. In 1869, Alfred Eustace also bought 10 acres of the Ullina run from Jason.

As it turned out, the Eldorado property lay across part of what was described at the time as "*the richest alluvial lead in the world*". Subsequent to the purchase in 1856 and under the newly granted Eldorado Pre-Emptive Right Act (which allowed a farmer to mine his own land) **Joseph Garlick** sank a goldmine shaft into the reef which "*was laminated, averaging a thickness of 8" down to 20 feet - a crushing yielding 3oz of gold per ton of ore dug*". Presumably, he made an unknown amount of money out of the exercise before he sold the property in about 1861 and moved his family to "*Lapthorne Farm*", nearer to Chiltern.

Interestingly, an official 1858 audit of **Joseph Garlick's 'Eldorado Station'** property yields the following interesting facts:

*"**Joseph Garlick** of the Eldorado run had 20 horses, 300 head of cattle, 600 sheep, 320 acres of freehold including 90 under cultivation and is credited with holding the whole acreage of the old Barambogie run (44,870 acres) though it is doubtful whether this is so; he was assessed at 71 pounds, but deductions brought it down to 56 pounds 10 shillings" .*

At one stage of his short life, **Joseph** was taught to paint by one of the renowned Chiltern locals, *Alfred William Eustace* . Some of **Joseph's** artwork was apparently passed on to later generations of Garlicks. When **Joseph** died at the relatively young age of 42 in 1871, at his own request he was buried near Deep Creek - about fifty yards within the eastern boundary of the then named "Eldorado Pre-Emptive Right". The undertaker at the time was Robert McLachlan of Chiltern.

The Joseph Garlick memorial site is at plot Presbyterian J7 in the Old Chiltern Cemetery. The headstone reads:

*"In Loving Memory -
Joseph Francis Garlick died 1871 aged 41 years. Also his wife Hepzibah Garlick died 2 Feb 1918 aged 87 years - Peace, Perfect Peace -
Also their son Septimus Garlick died 1872 aged 1 year 8 months and granddaughter Violet Myrtle Howard died 28 April 1895 aged 5 months - also their daughter Hepzibah Belcher Garlick died 22 Oct 1940 aged 74 years"*

Joseph married **Hepzibah Belcher** on 31 Oct 1853 in Church of St Peters (C of E), Melbourne, Vic.

Children from this marriage were:

- i. **Elizabeth (Bessie) Sarah Garlick** was born in 1855. Elizabeth married **? Eustace**.
- ii. **Frank Joseph Garlick** was born in 1857. Frank married **Rose**.
- iii. **Ellen (Nell) Amelia Garlick** was born in 1858. Ellen married **Warren**.
- 1 iv. **Mary Rose Garlick**. Mary married **Hugh Richard Cochrane** on 10 Apr 1883 in Chiltern at bride's residence.
- v. **William Garlick** was born on 18 May 1865 in Black Dog Creek, Chiltern, VIC, died in 1923 in Sydney, New South Wales, Australia at age 58, and was buried in Rookwood Cemetery, Sydney, NSW. William married **Charlotte Eleanor Seddon** on 5 Apr 1893 in Wangaratta Cathedral, Victoria, Australia.
- vi. **Hepzibah Belcher Garlick** was born in 1867 in Chiltern, VIC, died on 22 Oct 1940 in Chiltern, VIC at age 73, and was buried in Oct 1940 in Presbyterian Cemetery, Chiltern New Cemetery Vic. Plot J7.
- vii. **Ruth Garlick** was born in 1868. Ruth married **Arthur Levi Howard**.
- viii. **Septimus Edward Garlick** was born on 25 Jun 1870 in Black Dog Creek, Chiltern, VIC, died in Mar 1872 in Black Dog Creek, Chiltern, VIC at age 1, and was buried in Mar 1872 in "Laphorne Farm", near Chiltern, Vic..

3. Hepzibah Belcher, daughter of **Joseph Belcher** and **Sarah Malprest**, was born in 1831 in Warminster, Wiltshire, England, died on 2 Feb 1918 in Main St of Chiltern, Vic. at age 87, and was buried on 3 Feb 1918 in Chiltern New Cemetery, Vic.. The cause of her death was (1) Degenerative heart disease (2) Asthemia - 12 months.

General Notes: In the 1841 Census **Hepzibah Belcher** (aged 9) is recorded living in George St, Warminster, Wiltshire with father Joseph (basket maker - aged 50), mother Sarah (aged 47), brother Samuel (basket maker- aged 20), brother John (aged 15), sister Martha (aged 12), sister Ruth (aged 8) and brother Joseph (aged 5).

Hepzibah emigrated from England about 1851 when she was 20 years of age.

In 1918 at the age of 87, **Hepzibah** dropped dead in the main street of Chiltern from heart failure. Her occupation at the time was given as "domestic duties".

Hepzibah married **Joseph Francis Garlick** on 31 Oct 1853 in Church of St Peters (C of E), Melbourne, Vic.

Third Generation (Grandparents)

4. James Garlick, son of **James Garlick** and **Martha King**, was born in 1782 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England., was christened on 4 May 1783 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England., died on 13 May 1843 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England. at age 61, and was buried on 17 May 1843 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England.. The cause of his death was (1) Natural causes.

General Notes: **James Garlick's** parents were living in Gowles (or Goulds), Benson, nearby to Ewelme at the time of his birth.

On Joseph's death certificate, **James'** occupation is given as '*schoolmaster*'. This is confirmed in the 1841 Oxfordshire Census, which records **James Garlick** (schoolmaster - aged 50) living at the Ewelme School with his wife Elizabeth (aged 40), son William Allnutt (aged 19), son Septimus (aged 15), son Joseph (aged 12), daughter Rose (aged 10), son John (aged 9), daughter Ann (aged 7) and daughter Alicia Jane (aged 3).

At the time of the 1841 Census, the Ewelme School employed 5 female servants, 2 elderly persons of independent means (probably assistant teachers) and one 17 year old male usher to maintain some house order over the 48 young male students (aged 7-14) who were boarding there.

Two years later after **James'** death on 13 May 1843, the re-named "*Ewelme Commercial School*" had 30 pupils aged between 10-11 years studying for clerical jobs in London. His second wife Elizabeth Ann Garlick (nee Allnutt) became the schoolmistress after his passing. **James's** death was registered in Wallingford, Oxfordshire on 10th Jun 1843 after a coroner's inquest (he must have died at his home in Ewelme).

In **James'** will, he leaves everything to his wife Elizabeth, including his only real property - their leasehold house at Gould's Heath Common in neighbouring Benson.

James married **Sarah Mary Wilder** on 10 Jan 1807 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England.

Medical Notes: Since Sarah died very soon after giving birth to son John (who also died shortly after his birth) we can assume that she suffered a terminal complication from the procedure.

Children from this marriage were:

- i. **Mary Garlick** was born on 1 Nov 1808 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England. and was christened on 28 Dec 1808 in Private baptism in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England..

- vi. **James Garlick** was born on 22 Jan 1816 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England. and was christened on 24 Jan 1816 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England..
- vii. **John Wilder Garlick** was born on 22 Jan 1816 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England., was christened on 24 Jan 1816 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England., died in Feb 1816 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England., and was buried on 21 Feb 1816 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England..

James next married **Elizabeth Ann Allnutt** on 5 Apr 1817 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England.

Children from this marriage were:

- i. **Elizabeth Charlotte Garlick** was born on 3 Oct 1817 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England., was christened on 9 Nov 1817 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England., and died after 1891 in Oxfordshire, England. Elizabeth married **Thomas David**

- ii. **Anne Garlick** was born on 19 Apr 1819 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England., was christened on 17 May 1819 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England., died in Aug 1819 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England., and was buried on 31 Aug 1819 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England..
- iii. **William Allnutt Garlick** was born in 1822 in Meltham, Yorkshire, England, was christened on 3 Jun 1822 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England., and died between 1871 and 1881. William married **Elizabeth Ann Cottrell** on 9 Mar 1846 in All Souls Church, St Marylebone, London.
- iv. **Ellen Garlick** was born in 1823 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England., was christened on 23 Nov 1823 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England., and died after 1851. Ellen married **John Cottrell** on 18 Sep 1844 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England.
- v. **Charles Townsend Garlick** was born in 1825 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England., was christened on 5 May 1825 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England., and died between 1861 and 1871 in Sussex, England. Charles married **Maria Cooper** on 20 Aug 1850 in All Souls Church, St Marylebone, London.
- vi. **Septimus Edward Garlick** was born in 1826 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England., was christened on 4 May 1826 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England., died in Sep 1907 in Wallingford, Berkshire, Oxfordshire, England. at age 81, and was buried on 3 Sep 1907 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England.. Septimus married **Elizabeth ?** in Sep 1863 in Abingdon, Berkshire, Oxfordshire. Septimus next married **Elizabeth Cooper** in Dec 1897 in Wallingford, Berkshire, Oxfordshire, England.
- vii. **Frederick Octavius Garlick** was born in 1827 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England., was christened on 27 Sep 1827 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England., died in 1851 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England. at age 24, and was buried on 27 Feb 1851 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England..
- 2 viii. **Joseph Francis Garlick.** Joseph married **Hepzibah Belcher** on 31 Oct 1853 in Church of St Peters (C of E), Melbourne, Vic.
- ix. **Rose Catherine Garlick** was born in 1831 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England. and was christened on 4 Apr 1831 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England.. Rose married **Charles Evans** in 1854 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England. Rose next married **Unknown** in Jun 1861 in Henley, Buckinghamshire, Berkshire, Oxfordshire.
- x. **John Isaac Garlick** was born in 1832 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England., was christened on 8 Aug 1832 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England., died in Jan 1852 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England. at age 20, and was buried on 14 Jan 1852 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England..
- xi. **Anne Emily Garlick** was born in 1834 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England., was christened on 31 Mar 1834 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England., died in Feb 1853 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England. at age 19, and was buried on 3 Mar 1853 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England..
- xii. **Alicia Jane Garlick** was born on 26 Mar 1838 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England., was christened on 25 Apr 1838 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England., died in Oct 1855 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England. at age 17, and was buried on 21 Oct 1855 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England..

5. Elizabeth Ann Allnutt, daughter of **William Allnutt** and **Ann Bishop**, was born in 1794 in Towersey, Buckingham, England, died in Oct 1875 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England. at age 81, and was buried on 25 Oct 1875 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England.. Other names for Elizabeth were Ann, and Allnott.

General Notes: After her husband James passed away in 1843, Elizabeth took on the running of the "Ewelme School", which at that time still had 30 pupils (mostly London born who boarded at the school). They were presumably being trained for clerical jobs.

In the 1851 Census, Elizabeth (head school mistress - aged 55) is living at the "Ewelme School" with her son John Isaac (aged 18), daughter Ann Emily (aged 17), Sophia Clarke (visitor - aged 13), Eliza Chapman (visitor - aged 9). She employed 4 female house-servants, 2 male teachers and was boarding 27 male pupils (aged 8-15).

In the 1861 Census, Elizabeth (school mistress - aged 60) is living at the "Ewelme Commercial School" with her son Septimus (farmer & school master - aged 35). They employed 1 boarding

fundholder (or accountant), 1 assistant school master, 1 laundry maid, 1 cook and 1 housemaid. There were 42 male pupils (aged 4-16).

In the 1871 Census, Elizabeth (school mistress - aged 70) is recorded living at the "Ewelme Private School". She employed 1 governess, 2 male school masters, 2 female domestic servants and boarded 43 male pupils (aged 6-14).

Elizabeth married **James Garlick** on 5 Apr 1817 in Ewelme, Oxfordshire, England.

6. Joseph Belcher, son of **William Belcher** and **Elizabeth (Betty) Pinniger (Pinegar)**, was born in 1790 in Kington Langley, Wiltshire, England, was christened on 11 Jul 1790 in Draycot Cerne, Wiltshire, England, and died in Mar 1875 in Warminster, Wiltshire, England at age 85.

General Notes: In the 1841 Census **Joseph Belcher** (basket maker - aged 50) is recorded living in George St, Warminster, Wiltshire with his wife Sarah (aged 47), son Samuel (basket maker- aged 20), son John (aged 15), daughter Martha (aged 12), daughter Hepzibath (aged 9), daughter Ruth (aged 8) and son Joseph (aged 5).

In the 1851 Census, **Joseph** (aged 60) is recorded living at Marylebone, Middlesex, with his wife Sarah (aged 59). Later in 1853, Joseph's occupation is noted on his daughter's marriage certificate as "Baker", but this must be a mistake in translation, as he is still recorded as a "basket maker" in 1861.

In the 1861 Census, **Joseph** (basket maker - aged 70) is recorded living in High St, Warminster, Wiltshire with his wife Sarah (aged 66).

In the 1871 Census, **Joseph** (basket maker - aged 80) is recorded living in Portway St, Warminster, Wiltshire with his wife Sarah (aged 77). They both passed away shortly after in 1875.

Joseph married **Sarah Malprest** in 1819 in England.

Children from this marriage were:

- i. **Samuel Belcher** was born in 1821 in Warminster, Wiltshire, England and died after 1842. Samuel married **Anne Lidbury** on 28 Mar 1842 in Saint Denys, Warminster, Wiltshire, England.
- ii. **John Belcher** was born in 1826 in Warminster, Wiltshire, England and died after 1871.
- iii. **Martha Belcher** was born in 1829 in Warminster, Wiltshire, England and died after 1841.
- 3 iv. **Hepzibah Belcher**. Hepzibah married **Joseph Francis Garlick** on 31 Oct 1853 in Church of St Peters (C of E), Melbourne, Vic.

- vi. **Joseph Belcher** was born in 1836 in Warminster, Wiltshire, England and died after 1901. Joseph married **Catherine Dunton**.
